## The Three Weeks

### 1. When

- The Time period between the 17<sup>th</sup> of Tammuz and the 10<sup>th</sup> day of Av.
- This year the 17<sup>th</sup> of Tammuz begins Friday night, July 3, and the 10<sup>th</sup> day of Av ends Sunday night, July 26<sup>th</sup>.

### 2. Theme

- A. Time of national mourning and introspection to lead to spiritual improvement.
- B. Many tragedies befell our people during this time.
- C. Intensity of mourning increases and culminates on Tisha B'Av.

### 3. Activities during the Three Weeks:

- A. Weddings prohibited
- B. Engagements permitted
- C. Playing or listening to music prohibited
- D. Haircuts prohibited
- E. Shaving / Trimming beard prohibited
  - For business reasons please ask the Rabbi about one's particular situation.
  - If one shaves more than once a week there is a leniency to shave on Friday in honor of Shabbos.

- Married women and women of marriageable age can shave their legs if necessary. Women may tweeze their eyebrows.

- Combing hair permitted.

- F. Custom to not say the blessing of "Shehecheyanu" during weekday but permitted to say it on Shabbos.
